day of November being the first Monday of said month  
in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty  
for the purpose of giving in their votes for a Representation  
of said Commonwealth in the Congress of the United States  
for the Middlesex District. The whole number of votes  
given in, were sorted, counted, recorded and Declaration  
thereof made, as by law is directed - and were for the following  
persons.
