you are hereby required in the name of the Commonwealth of
Massachusetts to notify and warn all the male Inhabitants of the town of
Sudbury qualified by law to vote in town officers to meet at the Meetinghouse
in said town on Monday the 1st day of November next at 2 O'clock in the after-
noon on said day then and there to act on the following Articles (viz)

- 1st To choose a Moderator.
- 2^d To see if the town will choose an agent or agents to meet the County Commission-
ers on the 16th day of November next to oppose the laying out ~~the~~ of a road
Petitioned for by Samuel Townsend and others from Silas Brooks in Stow to
near the house of William Hunts 3^d in Sudbury. to do, or act any way on this
Article as they on this as they may think best.
- 3^d To appropriate any money not otherwise appropriated to pay the Assessors for
their services as Assessors the present year.
- 4th To Discount to Christ: J. Lutton cartin Taxes that he may offer to be
discounted.

And you are directed to serve this warrant by posting up attested copy
there of at the Publick meeting house in said town two sabbaths at least
before the time set for holding said meeting.

doings there on to our sives at time and place of holding said meeting.
