

March Anno Domini 1831

[L S] Middlesex Co. To Levi Smith Constable of the town of Sudbury
in said county greeting

You are hereby required in the name of the Commonwealth of the said
-Massachusetts to notify and warn all the male inhabitants of said town
qualified by law to vote in the choice of town officers and town
affairs to meet at the Meetinghouse in said town on Monday
the seventh day of March next at 12 o'clock M. then and there
to act on the following articles viz.

1st To choose a Moderator, Town Clerk, Selectmen, Town
-Treasurer, Assessors, Constable, School-committee and all
other town officers that are necessary to be chosen in the
month of March or April

2nd To see if the town will repair their highway, by a rate
the present year and grant a suitable sum of money
to repair the same

3rd To see if the town will give liberty for swine, Horses, Mules,
-Heads-Cattle and Sheep to go at large the present year without
a keeper

4th To see what measures the town will take in letting out the
poor of said town the present year for one or more
years to one or more contractors to do or act any way as it
respects the disposal of the poor as the town shall think
best when met

5th To see if the town will take the same measures in
letting out the collecting the taxes that may be assessed upon
the inhabitants of said town the present year as was adopt-
-ed the year last and agree with some suitable person
or persons to collect the same

6th To see if the town will choose a committee to examine
and allow ~~the same~~ ^{the same} accounts that may be brought against the town

7th To see if the town will allow to the soldiers belonging to
said town who actually did military duty by arming
uniforming and equipping themselves the last year not-
-withstanding they were not returned to the assessors
as doing all the duty required by law by the officers

8 To attend to the report of the Trustees of the Sudbury Ministerial
Fund Corporation
