Warrant for March Meeting brought forward

- 9th To see if the town will appropriate any unappropriated money now in the treasury to pay the costs that have arisen on an Indictment against the town for neglecting to repair their highways in 1829
- 10th To see if the town will appropriate any unappropriated money now in the treasury to pay a balance of five Dollars 91/00 due the Contractors for making the new Road in the south part of the town in 1830
- 11th To see if the town will choose a committee whose duty it shall be to make out a list of suitable Books for the use of the Summer and Winter schools and to report the same to the town at May-meeting for their consideration
- 12th To see if the town will discount to Levi Smith certain Papers that he may offer to be discounted: Also certain Papers to Christopher G. Cutler
- 13th To see if the town will divide the centre highway Ward so that two Surveyors may be chosen where now there is but one
by request of Capt Samuel Jones
- 14th To see if the town will give to the widow Sarah Haynes the Legacy that was willed to the town by her husband
by request of Warren Howe
- 15th To see if the town will take any measures for the purpose of erecting Hay-scales in said town
- 16th To see if the town will order any repairs to be made on the North road between Levi Smiths and Stand line — by request of Levi Smith

And you are hereby required to serve this Warrant by posting up an attested copy thereof at the public Meeting-house in said town two Sabbaths at least before the time set off for holding said meeting

Hereof fail not and make due return of this Warrant with your doings thereon to ourselves at time and place of holding said meeting
