

April 2d. 1831

At a legal meeting of the inhabitants of the town of Sudbury held on Monday the 4th day of April A.D. 1831 John Hunt was chosen Moderator Then under the 2^d Article John Hunt was chosen Town Treasurer and was sworn by the Town Clerk after the meeting - Then voted to take up the 5th article of the Warrant for March-Meeting which was referred to April-meeting and agreed with Thomas Stearns to collect the taxes that may be assessed upon the inhabitants of the town the present year for one & a half per. Ct. Then chose Thomas Stearns Constable who took the oaths of office after the meeting before the Town Clerk Asher Goodnow was chosen Pound Keeper in place of William Maynard declined and was sworn before the Town Clerk after the meeting -

3^d gave in their votes for County Treasurer and were for John Hayes forty nine votes

4th gave in their votes for a Register of Deeds and were for William F. Stone fifty seven votes

5th Voted to accept of the Settlement of the Selectmen with the Treasurer and ordered the same to be recorded as follows The subscribers Selectmen of the town of Sudbury having examined and ballanced the towns accounts respectfully submit the following Report

Whole amount of the grant in 1830 including the surplus and collecting is \$3077.64 of which sum the Treasurer has paid 2549.49
