To Thomas Stearns Constable of the town of
Sudbury in the County of Middlesex - - Greeting

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts you are hereby
required to notify and warn the inhabitants of the town of Sudbury
qualified to vote in town affairs also those qualified to vote in
Parish affairs to meet at the public Meetinghouse in Sudbury
on Wednesday the eleventh day of May next at 2 o'clock in the
afternoon then and there to act on the following articles

1st To choose a Moderator

2nd To grant money for the support of the Summer and Winter
schools and order how the same shall be distributed

3rd To grant the Rev. Rufus Hurlbut his salary in addition to
the interest arising from the Ministerial Fund

4th To grant money for the support of the poor the present year

5th To grant money to pay their expenses the present year

6th To grant money to pay the town Treasurer

7th To grant money to pay amounts allowed by the Committee
on amounts

8th To grant money to pay Contingent expenses

9th To see if the town will let out the taking care of the Meetinghouse
ringing the Bell and Digging graves as occasion may require.

10th To hear and act on all reports of committees that shall be
offered by committees chosen by said town

11th To see what further measures the town will take in regard
to the lawsuit between Sudbury and East Sudbury whether
to carry the same any further or to grant money or appropriate
any money now in the treasury to settle the same, to do
or act any way on this article as the town shall think
best when met.

12th To see what measures the town will take to settle the expense
of the lawsuit between Sudbury and Orange to grant
money to settle the same or any other way the town
shall think best
