14th To see if the town will grant money for the support of singing the present year

15th To see if the town will accept of a list of Juries as made out by the selectmen for their revision & confirmation or alterations

16th To see if the town will accept of a Road as laid out by the Selectmen for the use of Josiah Heywood Jr.

And you are directed to serve this Warrant by posting up an attested Copy thereof at the public Meeting house in Sudbury two Sabbaths at least before the time of holding said meeting

Hereof fail not and make due return of this Warrant with your doings thereon to ourselves at the time and place of holding said meeting
