At a legal meeting of the inhabitants of Sudbury held on Wednesday the eleventh day of May A.D. 1831 under the first article in the warrant for said meeting Elisha Thibbier was chosen Moderator

2nd The town granted for the support of the Winter schools \$375, for the Summer schools \$200, and \$45, for Wood for the several schools, to be equally divided among the several school districts

3rd Granted Rev. Rufus Marlhub Salary ————— \$457.95

4th Granted for the support of the Poor ————— \$850.00

5th Granted to pay the assessors ————— \$100.00

6th Granted to pay our Treasurer ————— \$10.00

7th Granted to pay amounts allowed by the Committee on

Poor amounts \$65.87
