Middlebury, Vt. August 13th 1831 pursuant to the within warrant I have notified and warned the male inhabitants qualified to vote in town affairs to attend at the time and place and for the purposes therein expressed

At a legal meeting of the inhabitants of Sudbury held on Monday the 22nd day of August D. 1831 the articles in the preceding warrant were acted upon as follows.

1st Chose William Brigham Moderator

2nd Voted to choose a committee to let out said road and to have five on said committee one in each school district then made choice of Asah Goodnow, Israel Maynes, Josiah W. Adams, Christopher J. Cutler & Paul Walker the committee were instructed to let out the road to the lowest bidder - Voted the sum of two hundred and fifty Dollars for the same -

3rd Voted the sum of fifteen Dollars for making the road for Josiah Maynes Jr. - then voted to give Josiah Maynes Jr. the fifteen Dollars provided he makes the road himself -

4th Voted to choose an agent to oppose the straightening and piece of new highway as prayed for in the petition of Levi Warren and others then chose Christopher J. Cutler for that purpose as an agent carried over
