1d. S. Middlebury Co. to Thomas Stearns Constable of the town of Sudbury  
in the county of Middlesex

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts you are directed to notify the inhabitants of the town of Sudbury, qualified to vote in town affairs to meet at the public Meetinghouse in said Sudbury on Monday the 24th day of October current at 1 o'clock in the afternoon then and there to act on the following articles

1. To choose a Moderator.

2. To see what measures the town will take respecting an Indictment against the town for neglecting to repair their highway leading from Stow line through the northerly part of Sudbury to Concord line (Upon which Indictment the inhabitants of the town of Sudbury are summoned to answer at the Court of Common Pleas next to be holden at Cambridge within and for the county of Middlesex on the second Monday of Dec. next) whether the town will repair said highway and grant a suitable sum of money for the same or do or act any way on this article as the town shall think best when met.

3. To see if the town will take any measures to repair or new build Landham Bridge to do or act any way as the town shall think proper.

4. To see if the town will give leave to Augustus Hunt to build a Tomb on the east side of Goodnow and Smother's Corners.
