Hereof fail not and make due return of this warrant with your doings thereon to ourselves at the time and place for holding said meeting.

Pursuant to the within warrant I have notified the inhabitants of said town of Sudbury qualified as therein expressed to meet at the time and place and for the purposes therein named.

At a legal meeting of the inhabitants of Sudbury held on Monday the 24th day of October D. 1831 the articles in the preceding warrant were acted upon as follows

1. Chose John Hunt Moderator

2. Voted to order the highway Surveyors to lay out what money they have due and to choose a committee to make such further repairs as in their opinion are necessary to stop the Indebtedment.

Then chose a committee of three viz. Capt. Israel Heywood Asher Goodnow & Christopher F. Cutler. Then chose Capt.

Israel Heywood as an agent to answer ^{at Court} to said Indebtedment.

3rd Voted to choose a committee to go on and build such a bridge as they shall think necessary — Then chose a committee of two viz. Capt. Abraham Goodnow & Capt. Wm. Brigham

4th Passed in the affirmative

Then voted that this meeting be dissolved
