

November D. 1831

At a legal meeting of the inhabitants of the town of Sudbury held on Monday the 14th day of November D. 1831 the articles in the preceding warrant were taken up and acted upon in the following manner.

1. Chose Enos Thidder Moderator.
2. Voted to give leave to have a Stove or Stoves placed in the porch of the Meetinghouse and the funnel passing into the house and up through the roof.
3. Voted to discount to Levi Smith Sally Hydens tax of forty six Cents, & David Smalls of ninety two Cents - and to C. J. Cutler Thomas Brigham of one Dollar forty five Cents also to Levi Smith William B. Whalers tax of thirty five Cents.
4. Voted to expune Thomas Stearns from serving any longer as Constable and then chose Christopher J. Cutler in his place who was sworn in open town meeting before the town Clerk.
5. Voted the agents be authorized to borrow money sufficient to settle with East Sudbury and costs of Court.

Then voted that this meeting be dissolved.
