

January 2d. 1832

At a legal meeting of the inhabitants of the town of Sudbury held on Monday the 30th day of January A. 1832 the articles in the preceding warrant were taken up and acted upon in the following manner.

1. Chose William Brigham Moderator.

Then voted to adjourn this meeting to Monday next at one o'clock in the afternoon.

Monday Feb. 6th 1832 the town met according to adjournment and proceeded to business by choosing Christopher G. Cutter Moderator pro. tem. Then took up the 2nd Article and voted to let out the poor the coming season to one contractor provided it can be done to the advantage of the town. Then voted to choose a committee to see what terms can be obtained and report at March Meeting. Then chose a committee of three viz. Capt. Enosh Thayer Asher Goodnow and Dury Fairbanks then chose Paul Walker instead of Asher Goodnow excused.

3. Voted to repair their highways the coming season by a money tax. Then voted to choose a committee to receive proposals from individuals to keep the roads in repair and report at March Meeting. Then chose Asher Goodnow Saml Thompson & Abel Dakin.

4th passed over.

Then voted to dissolve this meeting.
