Middlesex Co. To Christopher F. Cutter Constable of the town
of Sudbury in the County of Middlesex Greeting

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts you are hereby required to notify and warn the inhabitants of the town of Sudbury qualified to vote in the choice of town officers and town affairs to meet at the public Meeting-house in said town on Monday the 5th day of March next at 12 o'clock Meridian then and there to act on the following articles.

1. To choose a Moderator and all other necessary town officers.
2. To bring in their votes for County Treasurer.
3. To see if the town will give liberty for Swine, Horses, Mules, Cattle & Sheep to go at large the present year without a keeper.
4. To hear the Report of the Committee chosen at the last town meeting to receive proposals for keeping the highways in repair - And to adopt some suitable measures to repair said highways the present year or for more years than one as the town shall think proper - and to grant money to repair the same the present year.
5. To see what measures the town will take to make the road located on the petition of Asher Goodnow & others, agreeable to an order of notice received from the County Commissioners.
6. To hear the report of the committee chosen at the last town meeting to receive proposals for the support of the Poor the present year - and adopt some suitable measures for the support of said Poor.
