7. To see if the town will take any measures to purchase a Poor Establishment for the future support of the Poor of the town to do or act any way on this article as the town shall think proper.
8. To see what measures the town will take to collect the Taxes that may be assessed upon the inhabitants of the town the present year and agree with some suitable person to collect the same.
9. To see if the town will choose a committee to examine and adjust all accounts that may be brought against the town and allow the same if reasonable.
10. To hear the report of the trustees of the Sudbury Ministerial Fund Corporation.
11. To see if the town will discount to Thomas Stearns certain Taxes that he may offer to be discounted.

And you are directed to serve this warrant by posting up an attested Copy thereof at the Public Meeting house in said town two Sabbaths at least before the time for holding said meeting.

Hereof fail not and make due return of this warrant with your doings thereon to ourselves at the time & place of meeting as aforesaid.
