2. Votes for County Treasurer were for John Keyes eighty four votes.

3. Passed in the negative.

4. Voted to choose by ballot the same number of Highway Surveyors as last year and empower them to lay out the money that shall be granted & that they proceed strictly according to law — Then voted to empower each Surveyor to lay out his money at his discretion to hire such help as he shall choose and make his return according to law — Then voted to grant six hundred Dollars — Then voted that this grant be proportioned to the several Wards the same as last year — Then voted to take up the statute and chose as Highway Surveyors William Brigham
