7. Voted to purchase a Poor Establishment - Then voted to choose a committee of five by Ballot one from each School District to purchase a Poor Establishment provided they can find one within the year that in their opinion will be for the advantage of the town. Then voted to choose by Districts and chose for the Centre District, Luther Goodnow, Southeast, C. G. Cutler, Southwest, Buckley Howe, Northwest, Abel Cutting, Northeast, Israel Haynes. — — —

Then voted to take up the 6th article and voted to pass over the Report of the committee —

Then voted that the Poor be left to the Overseers of the Poor to let them out to one or more contractors for one year as they shall think best.

8. Put over to April meeting.

9. Voted to choose a committee of accounts of three and chose John Goodnow, Enoch Thierder & Phuben Haynes —

10. Voted to accept of the Report of the Sudbury Ministerial Fund Corporation and order the same to be recorded — which is as follows

An act of this Commonwealth of Massachusetts, passed June the 4th 1817 establishing a Ministerial Fund in the town of Sudbury, makes it the duty of the Trustees thereof to make a report to said town showing the state of said fund with their doings thereon at the annual Meeting in March or April —

Agreeable to said act said Trustees ask leave to report as follows viz. The funded sum amounts to three thousand two hundred dollars and ninety four Cents consisting of promissory notes of hand interest to be paid annually the 30th of August —

The interest arising from the above funded sum which was due August 30th 1831 the amounting to the sum of \$192.05 the Treasurer has since collected and paid to the Rev. Rufus Threlkild by order of said Trustees agreeable to said act of incorporation 224.1
