125. Middlesex Co. to Christopher G. Cutter Constable of the town of
Sudbury in the county of Middlesex - Greeting

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts you are hereby
ordered to notify and warn the inhabitants of the town of Sudbury
qualified to vote in the choice of town officers and town affairs
to meet at the public Meeting-house in said Sudbury on
Monday the 2nd day of April next at 10 o'clock in the
afternoon then and there to act on the following articles.

1. To choose a Moderator.
2. To choose a Town Treasurer and Constable and fill all
vacancies in the town offices.
3. To act on the 8th and 11th articles in the warrant for the last month
meeting which were put over to April meeting.
4. To see if the town will discount to Levi Smith certain Taxes
that he may offer to be discounted.
5. To see if the town will make their town grants after the
present year in the month of April.
6. To see if the town will appropriate fifty five Dollars 30/00
from the surplus of 1831 to pay the Assessors the balance that
is due them for making the Taxes and taking the Valuation
in 1831.
7. To see if the town will accept of the settlement of the
Selectmen with the town Treasurer and order the same to
be recorded.
8. To see if the town will take any measures to dispose of the
John Green farm to do or act any way on this article
as the town shall think proper.
9. To see what measures the town will take to defray the expense
of making a new road located on the petition of Samuel
Townsend and others.
