

Brought up May 1st 1832.

11. To grant money to pay their Bore Pay to those soldiers who shall do military duty the present year according to Law.
12. To see if the town will let out the taking care of the Meeting-house ringing the Bell and digging Graves as occasions may require.
13. To hear and act on all reports of committees that may be offered.
14. To discount to Thomas Stearns certain Tapes that he may offer to be discounted.
15. To discount to Levi Smith certain Tapes that he may offer to be discounted.
16. To see if the town will authorise the committee chosen to let out the road located on the petition of Samuel Townsend and others to petition the County Commissioners for an allowance from the County for making said road.
17. To see if the town will appropriate the money now in the treasury due on the Settlements of 1828, & 1830 for any town's purposes as the town shall think best.
18. To see if the town will choose a committee to wait on Mr. Thurlbut and request him to give his reasons if any he has why he declines exchanging with some of the neighbouring Clergy as he formerly did: to do or act any way on this article as the town shall think best.
19. To see if the town will enlarge or repair the Center school-house or take any measures to new district any part of the town to do or act any way on this article as the town shall think proper.
20. To see if the town will accept of a road as laid out by the Selectmen from the Berlin Road to land of Ephraim Moore.
