16. Passed over for the present then took up the 9th article and granted the sum of fifty Dollars towards paying for the road located on the petition of Samuel Townsend and others ————— \$50

Then took up the 17th article and voted to appropriate the sum of one hundred Dollars out of money now in the treasury (due on the grants of 1828, 29 & 30) towards defraying the expense of the aforesaid Road \$100—

Then voted to appropriate out of the aforesaid grants the sum of thirty nine Dollars 26/100 to pay for two Stoves purchased one for the Center & one for the Southwest Schoolhouse by Eddy Fairbanks and Silly Smith ————— \$39:26
Sixteen Dollars 63/100 can be paid \$16:63
\$ 33:26

Then took up the 16th article and voted that Asher Goodnow be authorized to petition the County Commissioners, for an allowance from the County for making the road located on the petition of Samuel Townsend and others

Then took up the 7th article and granted the sum of one hundred six Dollars 5/100 to pay amounts allowed by the Committee on accounts as follows ————— \$106.05
