18. Put over for the present.

19. Voted to choose a committee to examine the situation of our several school Districts and to report at a future meeting — then chose Capt. Samuel Jones, Israel Haynes, Charles Garry, Abel Dakin & Enoch Kidder.

20. Voted to accept of the road as laid out by the Selectmen from Berlin Road to land of Ephraim Moore — (which laying out is recorded in the town Records of Roads page 107) —
Then chose Capt Ephraim Moore agent to see to the making said road —

Then took up the 10th article and voted to pass over this article then voted to reconsider the last vote then granted the sum of forty Dollars to make the road located on the petition of Asahel Goodnow and others — \$40.00

Then took up the 3rd article and accepted of the offer of the Rev. Rufus Hurlbut and granted the sum of four hundred Dollars for his salary in addition to the interest arising from the Ministerial Fund — \$400 —

Then took up the 18th article and voted that the town would choose that Mr. Hurlbut would exchange with all the respectable clergymen in the vicinity as he formerly did — Then voted to choose a committee to wait on Mr. Hurlbut and request him to give his reasons why he does not exchange as he formerly did —
Then chose the following gentlemen — Rev. Samuel Puffer, John Goodnow, Christopher G. Cutter, Paul Walker and Luther Goodnow

Then voted that this meeting be dissolved
