Pursuant to the within warrant I have notified the inhabitants of the town of Sudbury herein described to meet at said time & place & for the purposes within mentioned by posting up an attested copy of this warrant at the public meetinghouse in said town two Sabbaths before the time set for this meeting

At a legal meeting of the inhabitants of the town of Sudbury held on Monday the 4th day of Feb. D. 1833 the articles in the preceding Warrant were taken up & acted upon in the following manner

1. Chose Samuel Puffer Moderator.

2. A copy of the Petition referred to in this article being read by the Town Clerk - it was moved to see if the town will assent to the prayer of said Petition as set forth in said copy and it passed in the negative by unanimous vote - Then voted to choose a committee to remonstrate against the Petition aforesaid that they use all fair and honourable means to prevent the granting of the same - that they give such information to our Representative in the General Court as they are able to procure and think necessary relative to said Land & Factory
