2. Votes for County Treasurer were for Wm. D. Chaplin
Twenty four votes, For John Thayer nine votes.
& for Levi Farnell one vote.

3. Passed in the affirmative.

Then voted to adjourn this meeting for one fortnight
at 1 o'clock in the afternoon at this place.

Monday March 18th D. 1833 the town met according
to adjournment & proceeded to business by taking
up the 4th article

And voted to repair their highways ^{the present year} in the same man-
ner as in 1831 - Then granted twelve hundred
Dollars - Then voted to allow the same price for labour

as in 1831 ~~which~~ which was 12th Cents per hour for a man

& the same for one John of Oxen - Then voted that

the assessors be directed to accompany their propor-
tion of Tax to each Surveyor of highways with a

warrant - Then took up the first article and voted

to choose their highway surveyors by Ballot & that each

District should choose its own Surveyor - Then
