To Willard Maynard Constable of the town
of Sudbury in the County of Middlesex — Greeting

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts you are
required to notify and warn the inhabitants of the town
of Sudbury qualified to vote in town affairs also those
qualified to vote in Parish affairs to meet at the public
Meeting house in said Sudbury on Monday the first
day of April next at 1 o'clock P.M. then and there
to act on the following articles —

1. To Choose a Moderator, town Treasurer & Constable &
fill all vacancies in the town offices.
2. To act on the 5. 9. & 10 articles in the warrant for ^{the} last
March meeting which were put over to April meeting.
3. To see if the town will accept of the settlement of the
selectmen with the town Treasurer and order the
same to be recorded —
4. To grant money for the support of the Summer
and Winter schools and order how the same
shall be distributed.
5. To grant the Rev. Rufus Thurlbut his salary.
6. To grant money for the support of the poor the
present year.
7. To grant money to pay the assessors the present
year.
8. To grant money to pay the town Treasurer the
present year.
9. To grant money to pay amounts allowed by
the Committee on accounts.
