10. To grant money to pay the money borrowed by the town the last year so far as the town shall think proper.
11. To grant money for the support of a singing school the present year.
12. To grant money to pay their Poll tax to those Towns who shall do military duty the present year according to law.
13. To see if the town will let out the taking care of the Meeting house ringing the Bell & digging graves as occasion may require.
14. To make all necessary grants and appropriations of money for municipal purposes for the year ensuing which may not be particularly mentioned in the preceding articles.
15. To hear and act on all Reports of Committees that shall be offered.
16. To see if the town will discount to Willard Maynard certain Taxes that he may offer to be discounted: also to Thomas Stearns Taxes that he may offer.
17. To see if the town will express their minds on the expediency of petitioning the Post Master General to discontinue the Post Offices in the South & North part of the town and to establish one in the center of the town.
18. To see if the town will order that the money granted the last year
