

April 2d. 1833.

At a legal meeting of the inhabitants of the town of Sudbury held on Monday the 1st day of April A.D. 1833 the articles in the preceding warrant were taken up & acted upon in the following manner.

1. Chose William Brigham Moderator & town Treasurer, chose of Constatle put over for the present & took up the
- 5th article in the Warrant for March meeting which was put over to April meeting and agreed with Willard & Waynerd to collect the taxes for one & three fourths of a per. cent. Then chose Willard & Waynerd Constables. Then took up the
9. article in the warrant for March meeting and voted to appropriate twenty seven Dollars 74cs from the surplus of 1832 to pay those Soldiers who have done military duty in 1831 & 2 and have not received their Poll tax. Then took up the
10. article in the warrant for March meeting which was put over to April meeting then voted to put over this article for the present & to take up the
4. article and granted two hundred Dollars for Summer schools and ordered it to be divided ~~\$200~~ equally among the several school Districts. Then granted 400\$ for Winter schools then voted that this money be divided among the several school Districts the Center District having 25\$ more than any other, the rest equal. Then granted \$50 for Wood for the schools to be equally divided among the several school Districts.
