April 2, 1833

10. Granted \$396.54 to pay money borrowed by the Committee chosen to let out the making of the Road located on the Petition of Samuel Townsend & others —
11. Voted to pass over this article.
12. Granted \$60 to pay Poll Tax to those soldiers who shall do military duty the present year and in 1834.
13. Voted that the selectmen let out the taking care of the meeting house Raising the Bell & Digging graves.
14. Granted \$32.52 to pay money borrowed by Isaac Haynes as agent for the town. —
Then took up the
1. article and chose Mr. Rice for school Committee in the Center District instead of Mr. Maynard expired.
- 15 Voted to accept of the Report of the Committee chosen to let out the road located on the Petition of Samuel Townsend and others as follows —

Your committee appointed at a former town meeting for the purpose of letting out the building of half of the Bridge and road located on the Petition of Samuel Townsend and others have attended that service and by leave to report as follows —

Let out the building of half of said Bridge for — \$300 —

Let out the road to sending persons for 408.18
\$758.18

August 22, 1831 the town granted for said road \$250 —

and in May appropriated — 100 — \$350.00

Interest from June to Feb. 19 on the Ballance — 15.92
\$424.10 248.1

Also granted for said road \$50. — which I received }
March 23 — 1833 \$50 —
