1833 Middlesex ss. To Willard Maynard Constable of the town of
Sudbury in the County of Middlesex — Greeting

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts you are hereby
directed to notify the inhabitants of the town of Sudbury
qualified to vote in town affairs, to meet at the public
Meeting-house in said Sudbury on Monday the 21st
day of Oct. current at 3 o'clock in the afternoon, then &
there to act on the following articles:

1. To choose a Moderator.
2. To see what measures the town will take relative to
an Order of Notice from the County Commissioners on
the petition of Luther Goodnow and others for pieces
of new highway & Straightenings in the old way from
Levi Smiths in Sudbury to the Meeting house —
3. To hear and act on all reports of Committees that may
be offered —

And you are directed to serve this warrant by posting
up an attested copy thereof at the public Meeting-house
in said Sudbury, two Sabbaths at least before the time
of meeting as aforesaid —

with your doings thereon to ourselves at the time and
place of meeting as aforesaid —
