In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts you are directed to
notify the inhabitants of the town of Sudbury qualified to vote in town
and Parish affairs to meet at the public meeting-house in said
Sudbury, on Monday, the eleventh day of November next, at
three o'clock in the afternoon, then and there to act on the following
articles:

1. To choose a Moderator.

2. To see if the town will purchase certain Plans of the town of Sudbury
of Mr. Wood for the use of the town.

3. To see if the town will discount certain wages to Willard Maynard.

4. To see if the town will repair Panty Bridge to do or act any way
in this article as the town shall think best.

5. To see if the town will authorize the present Overseers of the Poor to hire
a superintendant of the Poor Establishment for the year 1834.

6. To see if the town will take measures to cause all dangerous
places on the highways in town to be sufficiently railed,
to do or act any way as the town shall think best.

7. To see if the town will authorize some person or persons to
furnish Wood for the Stoves in the Meeting-house and agree
with some one to make fires in the Stoves.

8. To see if the town will authorize the Committee chosen to repair
Sherman's Bridge to procure materials from the Poor Establish-
ment to do or act any way as the town shall think best.

And you are directed to serve this warrant by posting up an attested
copy thereof, at the public meeting-house in said town two Sabbaths
at least before the time for holding said meeting.

Hereof fail not, and make due return of this warrant, with your doings
thereon, to the town clerk, at the time and place of meeting as
aforesaid.
