Brought forward

5. Voted That the present board of Overseers of the Poor be authorised to hire a superintendent of the Poor Establishment from the fifteenth of March next for one year and sixteen days.
6. Put over to next March meeting.
7. Voted to appoint some person to furnish Wood for the Stoves in the meeting-house & then chose Capt. William Brigham.
8. Voted That the Committee chosen to repair Shermans Bridge be authorised to select the timber for that purpose from the Poor Establishment - and if any trees should be cut that any part of them should be of more value than to use them for the repair of said Bridge, those parts should be sold by said Committee for the use of the town.

Then voted that this meeting be dissolved.
