128/ Middlesex Co. To Willard Maynard Constable of the town of Sudbury  
[28.] in the County aforesaid. — Greeting

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts you are directed to notify the inhabitants of the town of Sudbury qualified to vote in town affairs to meet at the meeting-house in said Sudbury on Monday the third day of February next at one o'clock in the afternoon then and there to act on the following articles, viz.

1. To choose a Moderator.
2. To see if the town will take any measures for straightening or altering the line between Sudbury and East Sudbury or act any other way on this article that the town may think best when met.
3. To hear Reports of committees if any there be and act thereon.

And you are directed to serve this warrant by posting up an attested copy thereof at the meeting-house in said Sudbury two Sabbaths at least before the time of holding said meeting.

Thereof fail not and make due return of this warrant with your doings thereon to the Town Clerk at the time and place of meeting as aforesaid.
