A Committee chosen at the December meeting to examine Parby Bridge have attended to that service and submit the following Report - we found the Bridge in a dangerous situation as to strength and width and your Committee do recommend widening to twenty feet and to be covered with stone if they could be procured at a fair price -

Then voted that the above committee be a Committee to cause a new Bridge to be built in a good substantial manner as will be in their opinion for the best interest of the town.

Then voted that this meeting be dissolved.
