In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts you
are directed to notify the inhabitants of the town of Sud-
bury qualified to vote in Elections and town affairs to
meet at the public meeting-house in said Sudbury
on Monday the third day of March next at 12 o'clock
Meridian there and there to act on the following articles

1. To choose all necessary town officers for the year ensuing
 2. To bring in their votes for a County Treasurer -
 3. To see if the town will restrain horses, neat cattle, sheep
and swine from going at large within the limits of
the town the year ensuing -
 4. To determine the manner of repairing the highways town-
ways & Bridges within the limits of the town the year ensu-
ing and to grant money for the same -
 5. To see what measures the town will take to collect the
Taxes that may be assessed upon the inhabitants of the
town the present year and agree with some suitable
person to collect the same.
 6. To see if the town will choose a committee on Accounts.
 7. To hear the Report of the Trustees of the Ministerial
Fund Corporation.
 8. To hear all reports of Committees that may be
offered and act thereon.
 9. To act on the 6th article in the last November
meeting which was put over to March meeting -
 10. To see if the town will appropriate all unappropriated
money whether in the Treasury or in other hands to
such uses as the town shall see fit -
