

Brought forward March 9. 1834

2. Votes for County Treasurers were for Levi Thayer One hundred and four - John Hayes twenty five.
3. Passed in the affirmative.
4. Voted to repair the Highways in the same manner as the last year - then voted to grant twelve hundred Dollars to repair the same - then voted that the pay per hour be the same as last year.
5. Put over to April meeting.
6. Voted to choose a Committee of three on Accounts then chose John Jones, David Howe, Levi Dow.
7. Voted to accept of the Report of the Trustees of the Ministerial Fund Corporation as follows.

An act of the Legislature of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts passed June 14th A.D. 1817 establishing a Ministerial Fund in the town of Sudbury making it the duty of the Trustees thereof to make a Report to said town showing the state of said Fund with their doings thereon at the annual meeting in March or April - Agreeable to said act said Trustees ask leave to report as follows viz -

The funded sum amounting to Three thousand Two Hundred Dollars and ninety four Cents consisting of promissory notes of hand interest to be paid annually the 30th of August.

The interest arising from the above funded sum which was due August 30th 1833 amounting to the sum of \$ 190, 85 the Treasurer has since collected and paid the Rev. Rufus Hurlbut by order of said Trustees agreeable to said act of incorporation.

The interest the past year falls short of previous years one Dollar and twenty Cents by money lying in the hands of the Treasurer before it could be loaned - all which is humbly submitted
