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To Willard Maynard Constable of the town of

Sudbury in the County of Middlesex. — Greeting.

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts you are hereby ordered to notify the inhabitants of the town of Sudbury qualified to vote in town affairs also all those qualified to vote in Parish affairs to meet at the public meeting house in said Sudbury on Monday the seventh day of April Next at one o'clock in the afternoon then and there to act on the following articles:—

1. To choose a Moderator, Town Treasurer & Constable and fill all vacancies in the town offices. —
2. To act on the 5th article in the warrant for the last March meeting which was put over to April meeting. —
3. To see if the town will accept of the settlement of the selectmen with the town Treasurer and order the same to be recorded. —
4. To grant money for the Summer & Winter schools and order how the same shall be distributed. —
5. To grant the Rev. Rufus Hurlbut his salary. —
6. To grant money for the support of the Poor the present year. —
7. To grant money to pay the sponsors the present year. —
8. To grant money to pay the Town Treasurer the present year. —
9. To grant money to pay accounts allowed by the Committee on accounts. —
10. To see if the town will grant money for a Singing school the present year. —
11. To see if the town will grant money to pay those soldiers who may be entitled to draw money from the treasury the present year. —
12. To make all necessary grants and appropriations of money for municipal purposes for the year ensuing which may not be particularly mentioned in the preceding articles and to appropriate any money now in the treasury for any of the purposes mentioned in the preceding articles as the town shall think proper. —
