13. To see if the town will let out the taking care of the meeting house ringing the bell and digging graves as occasion may require the present year.
14. To see if the town will make their highway Surveyors collectors the present year.
15. To see if the town will accept of a list of jurors as made out by the Selectmen.
16. To see if the town will direct the present board of Overseers of the Poor to report at the annual March meeting in 1835.
17. To see if the town will discount to Willard Maynard certain papers that he may offer to be discounted.
18. To hear and act on all Reports of Committees that may be offered.
19. To see if the town will call on their highway surveyors for the year 1833 and request them to show cause if any they have why they have not returned their books together with their doings and act any way on this article that the town may think best.
20. To see if the town will choose a Committee to repair their House and Meeting-house and Burying-ground.
21. To see if the town will take any measures to open a road formerly laid out between the farms of Mrs. Stone and William Goddard Jr. to do or act any way on this article as the town shall think proper.
22. To see if the town will grant money to pay for the repairs on Sherman and Panty Bridges.
23. To see if the town will take any measures to repair their Schoolhouse to do or act any way on this article as the town shall think proper.
