

Brought forward April 2d. 1834.

At a legal meeting of the inhabitants of the town of
Ludlow held on Monday the 7th day of April 2d. 1834
The articles in the preceding warrant were taken
up and acted upon in the following manner viz.

1. Chose William Brigham Moderator. William Brigham
town Treasurer. Chose of Constable put over for the present.
Isaiah Thompson was excused from serving as highway
surveyor - Then chose Levi Dow instead of him.
Then Enos Thierder was excused from serving as high-
way surveyor & David Lincoln was chosen in his room.
Then chose Edward Fisher Surveyor of Lumber.
2. Voted to take the same measures for collecting Taxes as the last
year and agreed with Willard Maynard for collecting
the same at 2 p. ct. - Then voted to take up the
1st article & chose Willard Maynard Constable.
3. Voted to accept of the Settlement of the Selectmen with
the town treasurer and ordered the same to be recorded
as follows - The Selectmen having this day examined
and balanced the town accounts with Capt. William
Brigham Treasurer hereby submit the following Report.
The amount of town grants for 1833 - \$2262.33

Surplus 107.71
\$ 2370.04

Of which sum the treasurer has since paid 1762.57
\$ 607.47

Due for Summer Schools - \$200 -
For Discounts 30 -
For Soldiers Poll Tax 80 -
Cash in Treasury 297.47 \$607.47

Cash in the Treasury appropriated

of the Poor } \$34.84

Due on the last year's Settlement - \$40.82
