18. Voted that the Overseers of the Poor be directed to enter a complaint in order that a Guardian may be appointed over Abigail Walker ~

(The above vote was put after hearing a verbal report of a Committee chosen at the last meeting on this subject)

19. Voted that the highway Surveyors for 1833 have the time to make their return lengthened out to the first of May 1834 ~

20. Voted that the Selectmen be a Committee to repair the Hearse & Hearse-house & Burying ground gate ~

Then voted to take up the 14th article & voted to make the highway Surveyors collectors the present year.

21. Voted to pass over this article.

22. Granted One hundred Dollars for Repairs on Sherman's & Parson's Bridges - \$100 -

23. Voted that the school Committee be directed to make necessary repairs on the several school-houses and bring in their Bill ~

Then voted to take up the 1st article and chose Nathan Thompson highway surveyor in the room of Levi Reed expired ~
The former vote under this article by which the town expensed Nathan Thompson was not reconsidered

Then voted that this meeting be adjourned
