

Sept. 2. 1834.

At a legal meeting of the inhabitants of the town of Sudbury
held on Monday the first day of Sept. 2. 1834 the articles
in the preceding warrant were taken up and acted upon in
the following manner—

1. Chose Capt. Wm. Brigham Moderator—

Then took up the

2. Article: Voted to choose a committee to state the facts
of this case to some able Attorney and get his opin-
ion and report at a future meeting— and that
the Committee get the case put on one Court—
Then voted to choose two on this Committee by Ballot.
Then chose Col. Fairbanks & Charles Garry— Then
voted that the Committee get a plan of the road
where the accident happened— Then took up
the

3^d Article— passed in the negative— Then voted to
reconsider the former vote— Then voted to choose
a Committee of three to meet a committee from
East Sudbury— Then chose Asa Goodnow, Paul
Walker & Filly Smith— then voted that the com-
mittee report at the next town meeting—
Then took up the

4th Article— And voted that this article be left to the
Overseers of the Poor—

Then voted that this meeting be dissolved.
