8. To see if the town will choose a Committee to purchase land for a Burying Ground to do or act any way on this article as the town shall think proper —

9. To see if the town will appropriate money to refund to the town's Committee money paid to Mr. Davis for examining and making a Plan of the Meeting-house in 1827.

And you are directed to serve this warrant by posting up an attested copy thereof at the public Meeting-house in said Sudbury two Sabbaths at least before the time for holding said meeting —
