

November D. 1834.

At a legal meeting of the inhabitants of the town of Sudbury held on Monday the 10th day of November D. 1834 the articles in the preceding Warrant were taken up and acted upon in the following manner -

1. Chose Capt. Wm. Brigham Moderator.
2. Voted to appropriate three Dollars 68¢ from the Surplus of 1834 to pay Thomas Stearns for John Sawyer's Tax in 1831 as expressed in this article.
3. Heard a verbal report from the Committee chosen to meet a Committee from East Sudbury and voted that this Committee be instructed to confer with a Committee from East Sudbury should one be appointed and settle the line ^{between the two towns} in the best manner as they shall think proper.

Heard the Report of the Committee on Sherman's & Panty Bridges and voted to accept of the Report & ordered the same to be recorded: as follows -

The Committee chosen to repair Sherman's Bridge and also the Committee to rebuild Panty Bridge report the whole amount of Labour done on Sherman's Bridge is \$36.47

Abel B. Richardson's Bill for Sawing Bridge Plank & Whulwright Plank \$1.58

John Jones Bill for Board, Timber & Labour 21.96

The whole expense of retiling both Bridges 35.99

Spikes & Nails \$2.04 Sundries \$8.93 3.02

10 3 days Work on a Road to procure Stone for Panty Bridge 4.50

The letting out of Panty Bridge 28.73
