

Brought forward November D. 1834

Heard the Report of the Committee chosen at the last town meeting to take advice on an action commenced against the town by Wm. Hunt 3rd and voted to accept of their Report and direct the same Committee to defend the suit lately commenced against the town as if one of their own — their Report follows —

Your Committee chosen in Sept. last for the purpose of taking advice on an action brought against the town for damages done to Wm. Hunt 3rd by overturning his chair near Pentry School House have attended to that service and ask leave to report as follows after obtaining the best information we could get we are of opinion that the action was brought without foundation and cannot be supported — since making out the above we have learned that there is a new suit commenced on an addition to the former —

4. Passed over the first part of this article as regards Discount to Willard Maynard —
then voted to discount to Thomas Stearns James Smith's Tax 53.5 — Nathan Carter's Tax 25.5. & Warren Maynard's Tax \$1.45 —
5. Voted to choose a committee to furnish Wood for the stoves in the meeting house — then chose Capt. Wm. Brigham —
6. Voted to exclude all religious meetings from the School-Houses —
7. Voted to appropriate fifteen Dollars 50¢ from the Surplus of 1834 to pay the balance of expense for the repair of Sherrill's and Pentry Bridges —
8. Passed over —
9. Voted to appropriate twelve Dollars from the surplus of 1834 to refund to the town's Committee money paid to Anora Davis —
then voted that this meeting be dissolved — Wm. Brigham Moderator
and Nathan Thompson clerk.
