12.9.1 Middlesex Co. To Willard Maynard Constable of the town
12.9.1 of Sudbury in the County of Middlesex — Greeting.

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts you are directed to notify the inhabitants of the town of Sudbury qualified to vote in elections and in town affairs to meet at the Meetinghouse in said Sudbury on Monday the second day of March next at twelve o'clock Meridian then and there to act on the following articles:-

1. To choose all necessary town officers for the year ensuing.
2. To bring in their votes for a County Treasurer.
3. To see if the town will restrain Horses, Cattle, Sheep & Swine from running at large within the limits of the town, the year ensuing.
4. To determine the manner of repairing the highways town ways & bridges the year ensuing and to grant money for the same.
5. To see what measures the town will take to collect the taxes that may be assessed upon the inhabitants of the town the present year and agree with some suitable person to collect the same.
6. To see if the town will choose a Committee to examine and adjust all accounts that may be brought against the town and allow the same if reasonable.
