To Willard Maynard Constable of the town
of Sudbury in the county of Middlesex - Greeting.

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts you
are directed to notify the inhabitants of the town of
Sudbury qualified to vote in town affairs also all
those qualified to vote in Parish affairs to meet at
the public meeting house in said Sudbury on Monday
the sixth day of April next at one o'clock in the
afternoon then and there to act on the following
articles -

1. To choose a Moderator.
2. To act on so much of the first article in the warrant
for the last March meeting as was put over to
April meeting & to fill all vacancies in the
town officers -
3. To act on the 5th and 9th articles in the warrant
for the last March meeting which were put over
to April meeting.
4. To see if the town will accept of the settlement of
the Selectmen with the town Treasurer and order
the same to be recorded.
5. To grant money for the Summer & Winter schools
and order how the same shall be distributed.
6. To see if the town will grant a suitable sum of
money in addition to the interest arising from
the Ministerial Fund for the support of preaching
the present year and order how the same shall be
paid out.
7. To grant money for the support of the Poor the present
year. ~~and order how the same shall be paid out~~
8. To grant money to pay the Assessors the present year.
