15. To hear and act on all reports of Committees that may be offered & grant money if the town shall think proper on any reports of Committees.
16. To see if the town will grant money to pay for making the road located on the Petition of Luther Goodnow and others.
17. To see if the town will accept of a road as laid out by the selectmen on the Petition of C. J. Lutterick also a road laid out by the selectmen on the petition of Ashbel Hayden. - and another laid out by the selectmen on the petition of Col. Ephraim Moore and others. also to discontinue an old way near Ashbel Hayden's if the town shall think proper.
