

Brought forward

5. Granted two hundred Dollars for the summer schools to be equally divided among the five school Districts - and four hundred Dollars for the winter schools to be equally divided among the five school Districts: also fifty Dollars for wood for the schools to be equally divided among the five school Districts.
6. Voted to grant four hundred Dollars in addition to the interest arising from the Ministerial Fund to pay the Rev. Rufus Hurlbut for preaching the present year.
7. Voted to grant One Thousand Dollars for the support of the Poor the present year, what remains from the support of the Poor to be applied to reduce the towns debt for the Poor farm.
8. Granted twenty Dollars to pay the officers the present year.
9. Granted ten Dollars to pay the town treasurer the present year.
10. Put over for the present.
11. Voted to pass over this article.
12. Granted fifty Dollars to pay those soldiers who may be entitled to draw money from the treasury the present year.
