Your committee chosen at our last annual meeting to consult Mr. Asa Jones and see on what conditions he will let his money remain in the towns hands, have attended to that service and ask leave to report.

After consulting Mr. Jones your committee find that he is willing to have two thousand Dollars of the money due him remain in the towns hands at five p. ct. p. annum.

The remainder he wants to make use of which will be two thousand Dollars, which sum can be had for six p. ct. p. annum for the towns security. — There is one thousand thirty seven Dollars 79/100 due Mr. Luther Goodnow which can remain unpaid at present at five p. ct. p. annum.
