

Brought forward, April D. 1835.

Voted to accept of the report of the schoolhouse Committee
then voted to defer acting on said report to a future
meeting —

16. Granted one hundred and thirty eight Dollars to pay for
making the road located on the petition of Luther
Goodnow and others.

17. Voted to accept of the laying out of the road by the select-
men on the petition of Christopher G. Cutler Esq. —
also to accept of a road as laid out by the Selectmen on
the petition of Ashbel Hayden & others and to
discontinue an old way as expressed in said
laying out — also to accept of a road as laid
out by the selectmen on the petition of Ephraim
Moore and others in effect as expressed in said
laying out — and granted thirty Dollars to pay
Christopher G. Cutler for making the road laid
out on his petition by the selectmen —
(The above laying out are recorded in the Book
of Records of Roads No 2.)

18. Voted to give liberty to Henry Plympton to enclose
with a fence the graves of his father & mother
and family connexions now buried in the
grave yard —

19. Voted to choose a committee to look up all lands belonging
to the town that can be disposed of — then chose
Asher Goodnow, Wm. Brigham & Luther Goodnow

20. Voted to pass over this article.
