Then voted to take up the 3rd article and agreed with Daniel H. Moore to collect the taxes the present year for one & seven eighths cent on the Dollar. Then voted to discount to Willard Maynard collector the following taxes

Capt. Wm. Rice one Poll Tax	\$1.40
Benjamin Smith's do	0.59
Abigail Duttons	0.82

Voted that the collector collect Luther Richardson's Tax

Voted to Discount Horis Walker's Tax	0.29
Samuel Chapen's do	1.11

Warren Howe's heirs put over for the present.

Discounted Sylvester Puffer's Tax - 1.11

Edward H. Gibbs do - 1.40

Daniel Smiths - do - 2.09

Then voted to take up the 2nd article and chose Daniel H. Moore Constable

Then voted to take up the 5th article and granted twenty five Dollars to be laid out in the small schoolhouse in the west part of the town.

Then voted that this meeting be dissolved.
