At a legal meeting of the inhabitants of the town of Sudbury held on Monday the 20 day of April A.D. 1835 the articles in the preceding warrant were taken up and acted upon in the following manner.

1. Chose Drury Fairbank Moderator.
2. Voted to pass over this article for the present & take up the
3. Voted not to give liberty to pasture the Burying Ground the present year.
4. Voted that the Town Clerk purchase a Book for town Records.
5. Voted to pass over this article.
6. Voted to choose a Committee of three to let out the making of the road located by the Selectmen on the petition of Ephraim Moore and others, then chose Capt. William Brigham, Paul Walker & Col. Ephraim Moore. — Then voted to take up the

2. Voted to choose a Committee of Conference of ten to report in half an hour, then chose Asher Goodnow Drury, Fairbank, John P. Allen, Timothy Johnson, Abel Dakin, Edward Brown, Asa Balcom, Willard Maynard, John Hunt Capt. Israel Hoynes — then voted to adjourn this meeting for half an hour — The Committee came in and reported that in their opinion it would be for the interest of the town to build three new schoolhouses one near Christopher F. Cutler's one near Drury Fairbanks & one near Abel B. Jones' and to move Panty schoolhouse to near William Hunt's Jr. — The town voted not to accept of said Report. —
